


FACTSHEET:

UN-SWAP System-wide performance on GEWE, the year of 2024

Contributions to SDGs: Most entities (58) aligned their strategic gender-related results with Goal 5, particularly on women's leadership (target 5.5) and ending all forms of discrimination (target 5.1). This was followed by Goal 8 (decent work) and Goal 16 (peace, justice). Fewer entities linked contributions to Goal 12 (Consumption), Goal 14 (Life below water) or Goal 6 (Clean water and sanitation), highlighting the need to mainstream gender considerations in non-traditional sectors
